

Room Descriptions – We hope this will help you in filling out your Room Request form!

Please remember that we assign rooms in the order we received your application and fee. All of our rooms are great, so even if you have the most recent application date you will still get a great room! We ask that you pretend you have the oldest date when filling out your room request form because you never know how the puzzle will fall into place! Visit our website at www.hardinhouse.com to see the floor plans and dimensions of all of our rooms. ** 2024-2025 rates will be published in January.

Main House – Ninety-four residents live in forty double occupancy rooms and four triple occupancy rooms in Main House on the 2nd and 3rd floors. This is the closest thing Hardin has to a “standard dormitory” set-up. Main has laundry rooms, a study room with a full refrigerator, microwave, Keurig Coffee Maker and an extra full bathroom. The first floor of Main House contains the Front Desk, a housemother’s apartment, the living room, computer room, study/tv room and the dining room. All rooms in this house have a ceiling fan. By summer 2024, all Main baths will be updated.

CATEGORY I - MAIN DOUBLE SHARED BATH: 203/303 A,B,C,D 204/304 A,B,D,E 205/305 A,B,D,E 207/307 A,B,C,D

These rooms are your most typical dorm-style. Four girls share a bath that is between two identical two-girl rooms with walk-in closets.

CATEGORY II – MAIN DOUBLE PRIVATE BATH WITH HALL WINDOW: 207L

This one-of-a-kind room is perfect for the girls who love to sleep late, as the only window is high on a wall that faces the hallway. This room has a private bathroom, two closets, plus an extra closet in the hall, which is keyed to the room.

CATEGORY II – MAIN DOUBLE PRIVATE BATH: 203/303 E 204/304 C 205/305 C 307 L

307L is exactly like 207L except 307L has a window to the outside. The other rooms in this category are two-girl rooms with private baths. There is one large closet in the room and another large closet in the hall, which is keyed to the room. 203/303E overlooks the pool.

CATEGORY II – MAIN STUDY SUITE TRIPLE SHARED BATH: 206 A,B 306 A,B

These triple rooms not only share a bath, but also share a large furnished study room with a full refrigerator and sink. Each bedroom has a walk in closet, and the study room has two individual closets.

Green House – Green House, located on the south side of Main House, was previously a fourplex and still has the four kitchens where residents gather to make cookies and chat! These kitchens have a full refrigerator & microwave. This house is best known for its high ceilings and white furniture. Twenty-nine girls live in Green House in single and double rooms. The bathrooms in this house were renovated in 2022. All rooms in this house have a ceiling fan. There are two study/lounge rooms in Green House.

CATEGORY I – GREEN SINGLE SHARED BATH: 101A, 201A

These two cozy rooms each share a bath with 101B & 201B respectively. They both face the alley side of the building and each have a large single closet.

CATEGORY I – GREEN SINGLE SHARED BATH: 202A

This single room shares a bath with the two girls in 202B. The window in this room is high on one wall and faces a study room, which is the only source of natural sunlight. The single closet is very large.

CATEGORY I – GREEN DOUBLE SHARED BATH: 101 B,C,D 102 C,D 201 B,C,D 202 B,C,D 200A

These rooms are all double occupancy but each has their own unique character. The 101/102 rooms are downstairs and the 201/202 rooms are upstairs with the 101/201’s facing the alley and the 102/202’s facing the pool. The “B” & “D” rooms are square with two separate closets, while the “C” rooms are rectangular with one large closet. The two girls in each “B” room share a bath with their single room neighbor. The “C” & “D” rooms share a bath. Upstairs only, the “C” & “D” rooms also each share a bath with one resident from 200A, making five girls in each of those bathrooms. Green 200A is a one-of-a-kind double occupancy room with large windows on two sides and faces Rio Grande. There are two closets in the room with extra storage cabinets in the hallway. 200A baths are down the hall & have ample storage with one girl sharing with 201 C&D and the other with 202 C&D.

CATEGORY II – GREEN DOUBLE PRIVATE BATH: 102B

102B has the ONLY private bathroom in Green House and is generally assigned to those with an older application date. The bathroom is in the hallway next to the room. There is one walk-in closet, and a spacious entry to the room.

Grant House – Through the breezeway beyond The Apartments is Grant House, which houses twenty-seven residents in nineteen single, double and triple occupancy rooms. Grant House, previously known as “New House”, was remodeled in 1998 and now has a predominance of private baths. Grant boasts large living areas, a full kitchen, courtyard, computer nook, laundry and exercise room on the first of two floors. All Grant House rooms include a television in room. The rooms that begin with a “1” are on the first floor and the ones beginning with a “2” are on the 2nd floor.

CATEGORY I – GRANT DOUBLE SHARED BATH: 1110

This double occupancy room shares its connecting bath with 1108, which is a single occupancy room, so three residents share the bath. It has a great courtyard view and a walk-in closet. A mounted television comes with the room.

CATEGORY I – GRANT SINGLE SHARED BATH: 1104

This single occupancy room shares its bath with 1103, which is a double occupancy room. The bathroom for three opens to the hallway between the two rooms. 1102, 1103 and 1104 are in a “cul-de-sac” of their own, with a small sitting area outside the rooms. A mounted television comes with the room.

CATEGORY I – GRANT DOUBLE PRIVATE BATH: 2205 & 2206

Facing the courtyard, 2206 is the smallest double occupancy, private bath room in Grant House, with a large walk-in closet. A mounted television comes with the room.

CATEGORY II – GRANT LARGE SINGLE SHARED BATH: 1108

This single occupancy room shares a bath with 1110, which is a double occupancy room, so three residents share the bath. It has a great courtyard view and a walk-in closet. A mounted television comes with the room.

CATEGORY II – GRANT LARGE DOUBLE SHARED BATH: 1103

This double occupancy room shares a bath with 1104, a single occupancy room. The bathroom for three opens to the hallway between the two rooms. This room is quite large and has a single, large walk-in closet. 1102, 1103 and 1104 are in a “cul-de-sac” of their own, with a small sitting area outside the rooms. A mounted television comes with the room.

CATEGORY II – GRANT TRIPLE PRIVATE BATH: 1102

The only triple occupancy room in Grant House, 1102 has a private bath and Container Store designed closet. A mounted television comes with the room.

CATEGORY II – GRANT LARGE SINGLE PRIVATE BATH: 1105, 1106, 1107, 2201, 2203, 2204

These seven rooms are large, single occupancy rooms, all having huge walk-in closets and private baths. 1106 and 2204 face the inner courtyard. The remainder of the rooms face south towards the alley. Need your privacy – great! Want friends – open your door to your hallmates! A television comes mounted in each bedroom.

CATEGORY II – GRANT DOUBLE PRIVATE BATH: 1109, 2202, 2207

These three rooms are double occupancy rooms in the house, each with their own private bath. 1109 and 2207 are at the ends of their hallways and boast large walk-in closets located off their bathrooms. 2202 overlooks the inner courtyard and has one walk-in closet in the room. A television comes mounted in each bedroom.

CATEGORY II – GRANT SINGLE BEDROOM SUITE WITH FULL SHARED BATH: 1100A, 1100B, 1100C

This suite of three bedrooms is located off the living room through a door to a private hallway, which can be locked, if desired. These three single occupancy rooms share a bathroom in the private hallway. 1100A has a vaulted ceiling, a walk-in closet and faces the inner courtyard. 1100B has a window to the courtyard and a large closet. 1100C faces 22 ½ Street with a large closet and a wall of windows. These rooms would be great for three friends wanting their own rooms, yet together in their own private corner of the house. A television comes mounted in each bedroom.

The Apartments – Although our ten apartments, located right outside the door from our dining room, are truly styled like apartments, each consisting of a living room, kitchen, dining area, bedroom and private bath, they are very much part of the dormitory. The Apartments are just another choice of living style we offer. Each apartment is uniquely furnished and offers a great choice for those who want a little extra room, access to a kitchen or the space for movie nights! All Apartments include a television in the living room. The upstairs apartments have vaulted ceilings. A total of twenty girls live in The Apartments. A laundry room is located in the apartment courtyard.

CATEGORY II - APARTMENT DOUBLE PRIVATE BATH: 104, 108, 109, 110, 111, 208, 209, 210, 211, 212

9 of the apartments are located on two floors with doors opening to a shared courtyard. These rooms are steps from the dining room and are located just behind Main House. Apartment 104 has is across the courtyard from the rest of the apartments with a back door to the courtyard and a front door to the 1st floor of Main House. Apartment 212 has it's own unique layout. A television is provided in each apartment living room.

Red House & Red Annex – Red House and Red Annex are located across the street from the Main House Front Desk. It is the original Hardin House building and are generally the most requested houses which fill first with early application dates. The rooms in Red House are large, with good-sized closets and high ceilings. Many of these rooms are triple occupancy, so be prepared to share your room and bath with others! Because of the many three girl rooms, this house is dense with girls and is best for someone who can study and sleep with a lot of activity. There are forty-three girls in the main Red House building and eighteen in Red Annex. Annex consists of six triple occupancy rooms on two floors with doors opening to the pool courtyard. Two of these rooms have private baths and the other four share a bath with an adjoining triple room. In the main Red House building, rooms AA, BB and 1-5 are on the 1st floor along with a housemother's apartment; rooms 6-16 are on the 2nd floor. Red House also has a study and computer room as well as a small cardio and laundry room. There is a kitchenette on each floor of Red House. Red House residents join the rest of Hardin House in the one dining room located in Main House across the street. All rooms in Red House are in Category II.

CATEGORY II - RED DOUBLE SHARED BATH: 6, 8, 9, 10, 11

These second floor, double occupancy rooms each have their own unique floor plan. A large bath, located in the hallway at the top of the stairs, is for rooms 6, 7, 8 and 9 to share. Although nine girls share the bath, it has two sinks, two showers and two commodes. Room 6 has a view to the north with large windows and two closets. Room 8 is unique with a pole in the middle and overlooks Rio Grande Street with two separate closets. Room 9 has a southern view and one larger closet. The bath for rooms 10 and 11 is across the hall from the rooms. Both 10 and 11 face south with two closets in each. Room 11 has windows on two sides.

CATEGORY II – RED TRIPLE SHARED BATH: 7

Going upstairs, Red 7 is a triple occupancy room with a view of Rio Grande. This room shares a bath with rooms 6, 8 and 9 and has two large closets.

CATEGORY II – RED LARGE DOUBLE SHARED BATH: 4,5,15, BB

These rooms are double occupancy, shared-bath rooms in Red House. Red 4 has one large closet and shares a bath with a triple room. Red 5 and BB share a bath and have two closets in each. Red 15, like Red 4 below it, has one closet and shares a bath a triple room

CATEGORY II – RED DOUBLE PRIVATE BATH: 16, AA

Red 16 and AA are the only private-bath rooms inside Red and generally are the first rooms to be requested. Red AA is downstairs with one closet and a small bathroom attached. Red 16 is upstairs with two closets and a larger bathroom attached.

CATEGORY II – RED TRIPLE SHARED BATH: 1,2,3,12,13,14

These are the 6 triple occupancy rooms in the main house of Red. They each have two extraordinary closets. Red 3 & 14 share baths with double occupancy rooms, therefore having five to each bath. Rooms 1 & 2 share a bath, as do rooms 12 & 13, hence each have six girls sharing the baths.

CATEGORY II – RED ANNEX TRIPLE SHARED BATH: 1A, 2A, 4A, 5A

These four triple occupancy rooms have six girls sharing each bath. 1A & 2A share a bath downstairs and 4A & 5A share upstairs. Each of these rooms has three walk-in closets.

CATEGORY II – RED ANNEX TRIPLE PRIVATE BATH: 3A, 6A

These two triple occupancy rooms in the Red Annex each have a small private bath with three separate closets.
