This Privacy Policy describes Our policies and procedures on the collection, use and disclosure of Your information when You use the Service and tells You about Your privacy rights and how the law protects You.

We use Your Personal data to provide and improve the Service. By using the Service, You agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

Interpretation and Definitions

Interpretation

The words whose initial letters are capitalized have meanings defined under the following conditions. The following definitions shall have the same meaning regardless of whether they appear in singular or in plural.

Definitions

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy:

- **Account** means a unique account created for You to access our Service or parts of our Service.
- **Affiliate** means an entity that controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with a party, where "control" means ownership of 50% or more of the shares, equity interest or other securities entitled to vote for election of directors or other managing authority.
- **Company** (referred to as either "the Company", "We", "Us" or "Our" in this Agreement) refers to **SVN Commercial Property Management, 5553 S. Peoria Ave, Tulsa, OK 74105.**
- **Cookies** are small files that are placed on Your computer, mobile device or any other device by a website, containing the details of Your browsing history on that website among its many uses.
- **Country** refers to: Oklahoma, United States.
- **Device** means any device that can access the Service such as a computer, a cell phone or a digital tablet.





- **Personal Data** is any information that relates to an identified or identifiable individual.
- **Service** refers to the Website.
- **Service Provider** means any natural or legal person who processes the data on behalf of the Company. It refers to third-party companies or individuals employed by the Company to facilitate the Service, to provide the Service on behalf of the Company, to perform services related to the Service or to assist the Company in analyzing how the Service is used.
- **Usage Data** refers to data collected automatically, either generated by the use of the Service or from the Service infrastructure itself (for example, the duration of a page visit).
- **You** means the individual accessing or using the Service, or the company, or other legal entity on behalf of which such individual is accessing or using the Service, as applicable.

Collecting and Using Your Personal Data

Types of Data Collected

Personal Data

Usage Data

Usage Data is collected automatically when using the Service.  - **Cookies Policy Acceptance:** To identify if users have accepted the use of cookies.
 - **Functionality Cookies:** To remember choices You make (like login details) to provide a personal experience.

Use of Your Personal Data

The Company may use Personal Data for the following purposes:

- **To provide and maintain our Service**, including monitoring usage.
- **To manage Your Account** and Your registration as a user.
- **For the performance of a contract** for services or products purchased.
- **To contact You** by email, telephone, SMS, or push notifications regarding updates.
- **To provide You with news and offers** similar to those you have already inquired about.
- **To manage Your requests** and attend to your inquiries.

Sharing Your Information: We may share Your information with Service Providers, for business transfers (mergers), with Affiliates, with business partners, or with Your explicit consent.

Retention and Transfer of Data

The Company will retain Your Personal Data only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. Your information is processed at the Company's operating offices and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located. Your consent to this Privacy Policy represents Your agreement to that transfer.

Delete Your Personal Data

You have the right to delete or request that We assist in deleting the Personal Data that We have collected about You. You may update, amend, or delete Your information at any time by signing in to Your Account or by contacting Us directly.





Disclosure of Your Personal Data

- **Business Transactions:** If the Company is involved in a merger, acquisition or asset sale, Your Personal Data may be transferred.
 - **Law enforcement:** We may be required to disclose Your Personal Data if required to do so by law or in response to valid requests by public authorities.
