

Trash and Recycling Schedule

Trash and recycling are picked up every Monday.

Please note: Tuesday pick-up will occur during holiday weeks.

Please be sure to have your cans out no later than 7 a.m. on pick-up days AND be sure to roll them back in no later than 7 p.m. on pick up days. **Bulk pick up occurs twice a year typically in May and November. Residents will be informed via email, automated call, text and Facebook posts prior to these dates. Bulk trash cannot be left by the curb with weekly trash.**

Please Recycle These Items!

- 1 Newspapers
- 2 Brown Paper Bags
- 3 Corrugated Cardboard
Remove plastic wrappers and flatten
- 4 Paperboard
Like cereal and shoe boxes, remove plastic liners
- 5 Milk Cartons and Drink Boxes
- 6 Molded Fiberboard
- 7 Magazines and Catalogs
- 8 Phonebooks
- 9 Printing and Writing Paper
- 10 Mail
Envelope windows and labels are OK, remove other non-paper items
- 11 Other Paper
Pamphlets, brochures, file folders, cards
- 12 Plastic (PETE) Bottles
Soda, water, etc., No trays or baskets
- 13 Plastic (HDPE) Bottles and Jugs
Milk, water, juice, liquid detergent, shampoo, etc. No hazardous material containers*
- 14 Aluminum Cans
- 15 Steel / Tin Cans
Non-hazardous aerosol cans are OK. Please no other steel
- 16 Glass Food and Beverage Bottles and Jars
No other glass

*Hazardous materials include herbicides, fluids, pool etc.

Only shredded paper should be placed in a sealed clear plastic bag.

These Items Are NOT Recyclable

- Plastic bags or plastic film packaging
- Any tubs, pails or buckets
- Food waste
- Food service items, such as cups or plates
- Napkins, paper towels
- Aluminum foil or pie plates
- Tissue or gift wrap
- Pet food bags
- Newspapers in plastic bags or wrapped in twine
- Yard trimmings, dirt
- Blankets, towels, pillows
- Kitchen utensils
- Appliances
- Furniture, draperies
- Toys, piñatas
- "Styrofoam"
- Packing peanuts
- Auto parts
- Electronics
- Light bulbs, window glass or ceramics
- Clothing or shoes
- Diapers
- Tarps, hoses
- Construction materials: lumber, drywall, etc.
- Books, photographic paper, tapes, CDs
- Medical supplies, syringes, lancets or other sharp objects
