- PCS orders to Fort Knox (RFO is accepted until official orders are received)
- Current DD form 1172 (DEERS enrollment). This is only needed if dependents' names are not listed in the orders.
- Current end of month LES
- Approved DA Form 31
- Additional documents may be required. Please call our Leasing Office at 502-799-6550 for more information.

# Understanding the Wait List for Military Personnel

## How do I get my name added to the wait list?

The eligibility date for housing at Knox Hills is the date of departure from the last duty station as recorded on Military Form DA31. When Knox Hills receives an advanced application, the member is placed on the wait list in an **Admin HOLD until all documents are received**. The Service Member is NOT eligible to sign for a home until they have out-processed from their prior duty station. New arrivals to Knox Hills wishing to use the “date of departure” from their last duty station as an eligibility date for a home must submit an application within 30 calendar days of arrival. If an application is submitted later than 30 days, the eligibility date becomes the date their rental application was submitted. If a home is not immediately available for a Service Member, their name will be placed on a wait list based on their eligibility date and in accordance with the priorities.

## How does the wait list work?

The wait list is organized and divided by rank and bedroom requirement. Leasing of homes is conducted using the centralized waitlist. The first eligible Service Member on the list is contacted when a home becomes available. If a Service Member declines the

first home offered, they will maintain their position on the waitlist. If a Service Member turns down a second home, they will remain on the waitlist, but their name will be moved to the bottom of the list. Placement in a particular residential neighborhood at Knox Hills is contingent on rank/grade and bedroom requirements.

## Can I choose the home/neighborhood where I want to live?

Service Members have the option of requesting a home in a specific neighborhood in which their rank/grade qualifies them for, however the request might increase their wait time for a home.

If a Service Member signs a lease for a home off-post due to extended wait times for a qualifying home at Knox Hills, they will be categorized on the Knox Hills wait list as **“LEASE HOLD.”** Their name will continue to move up the list, however a home will not be offered until they are within the timeframe of their off-post home’s lease expiration date unless otherwise notified by the Service Member.

## Wait List Priorities

The order for placement on the Knox Hills wait list is as follows:

### Priority 1

- Key & Essential personnel as identified by Fort Knox policy
- Forced Moves - families currently residing in Knox Hills housing who are forced to move due to renovations and/or demolition
- Priority Medical Moves - as directed via Memorandum from the Deputy Commander of Clinical Services at Ireland directly to the Leasing Office. (Families must also be currently enrolled in EFMP at Ft. Knox to be eligible).
- Service Members currently on PCS orders to Fort Knox who have signed out of their previous duty station
- Service Members currently stationed at Ft. Knox who are living off post
- Service Members who are deployed or back from deployment and do not have a home on the installation
- All other incoming residents who do not currently have a home on the installation

### Priority 2

- Current Service Members with increased bedroom requirements due to a change in dependent status
- Current Service Members who have received a promotion in rank/pay grade which has caused them to be over-ranked for the current neighborhood of which they reside at Knox Hills
- Current Service Members who are eligible Deployed Spouses Program participants

### Priority 3

- Residents who are requesting to move to another qualifying home on post after the original 12-month lease has been fulfilled on their current home.



# Applying for a Home

## DoD employees, DoD contractor employees and retirees

Knox Hills offers housing to all branches of the military, including military and Federal Civil Service retirees, Federal Agency employees and DoD contractor employees. Houses are leased unfurnished and include basic electricity/gas, water and sewer, trash and recycle pickup, 24/7 emergency maintenance and lawn mowing services. There is a two-pet limit (dogs, cats or combination) with a one-time, non-refundable pet fee (certain breed restrictions apply).

**Application Screening:** An application fee is charged for appropriate background checks and credit checks.

**Lease Term:** The lease term is 12 months with the option to renew for an additional 12 months or extend on a month-to-month basis after the initial term of the lease.

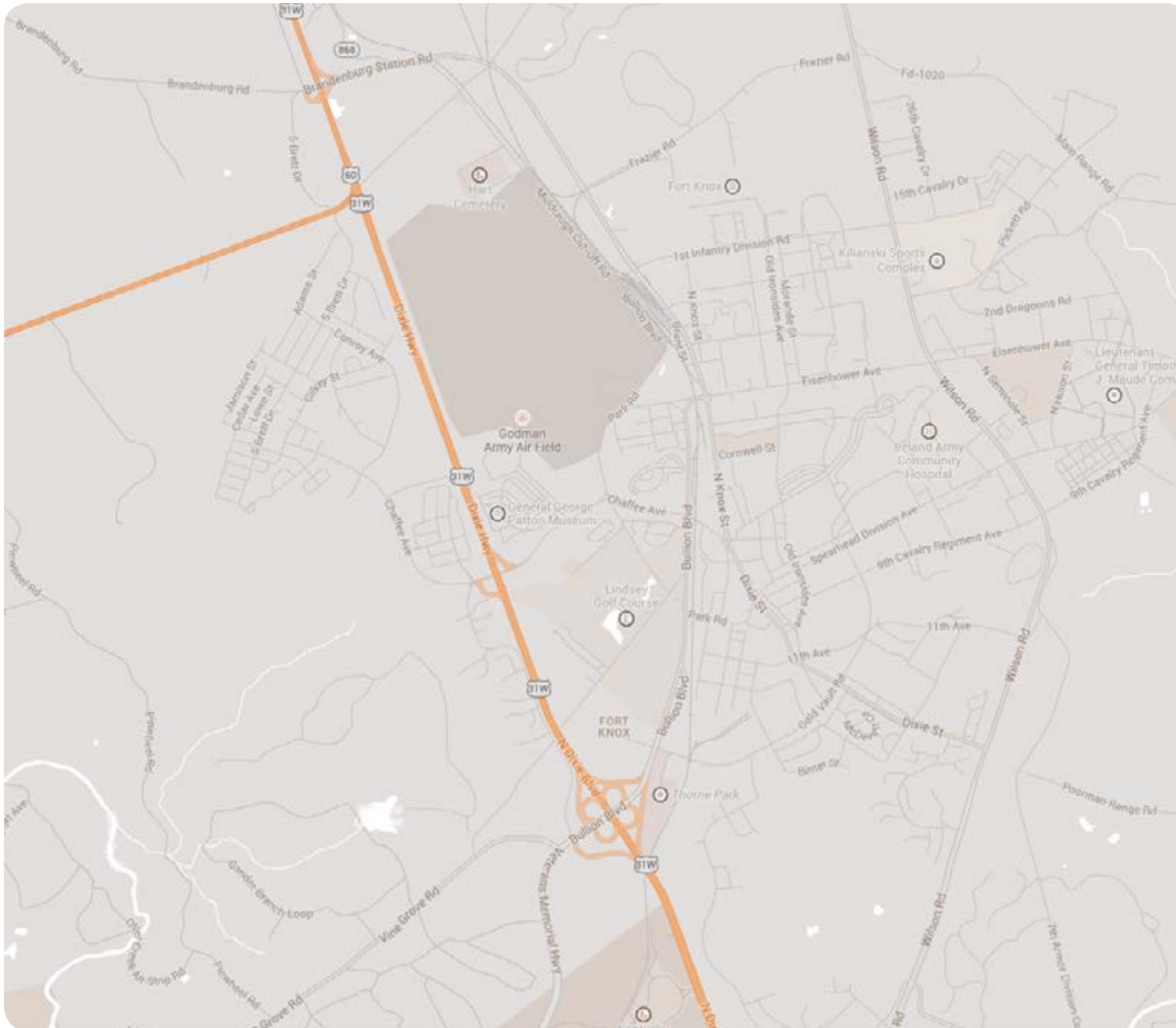

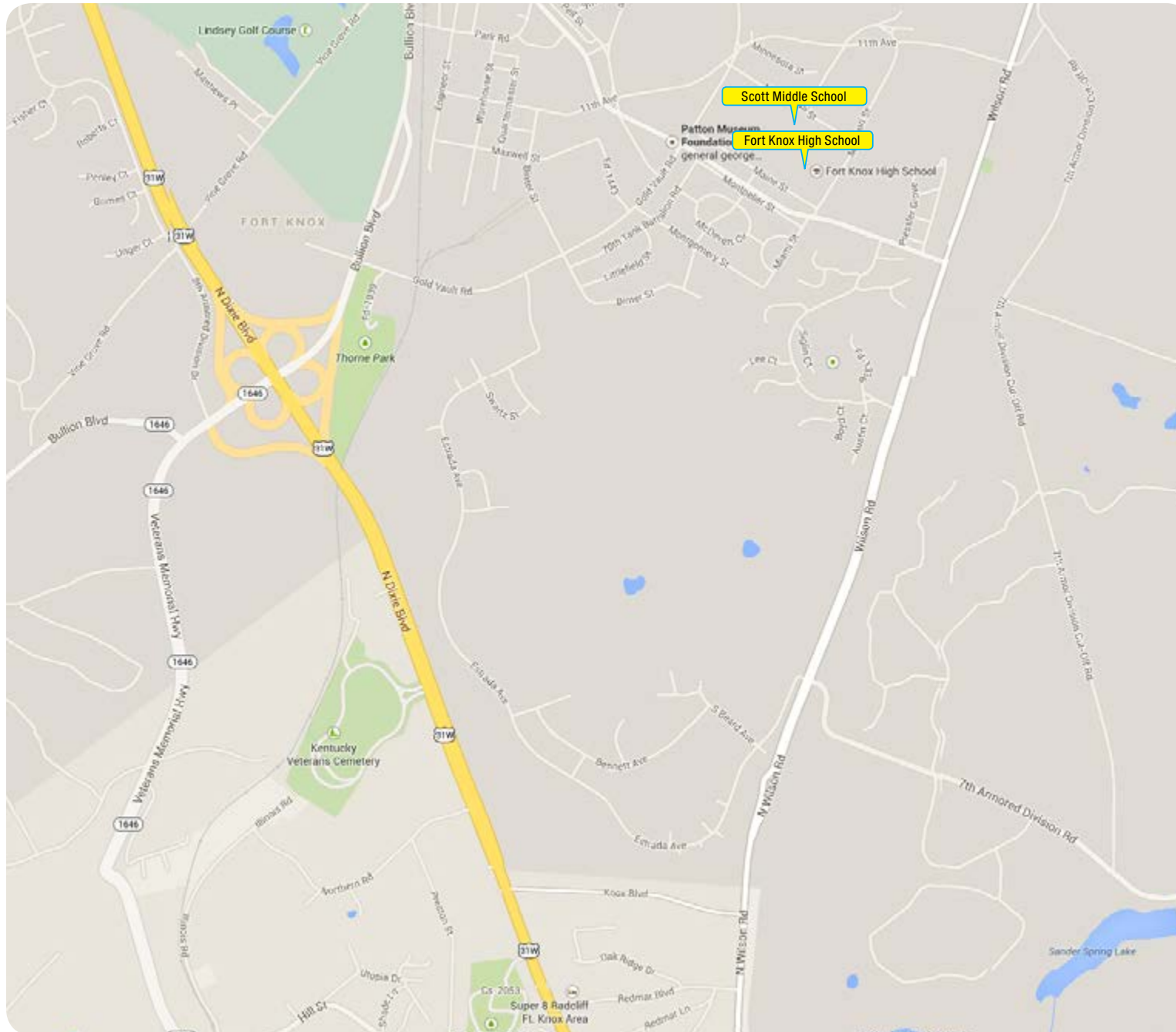


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# Map of North/South Dietz Community

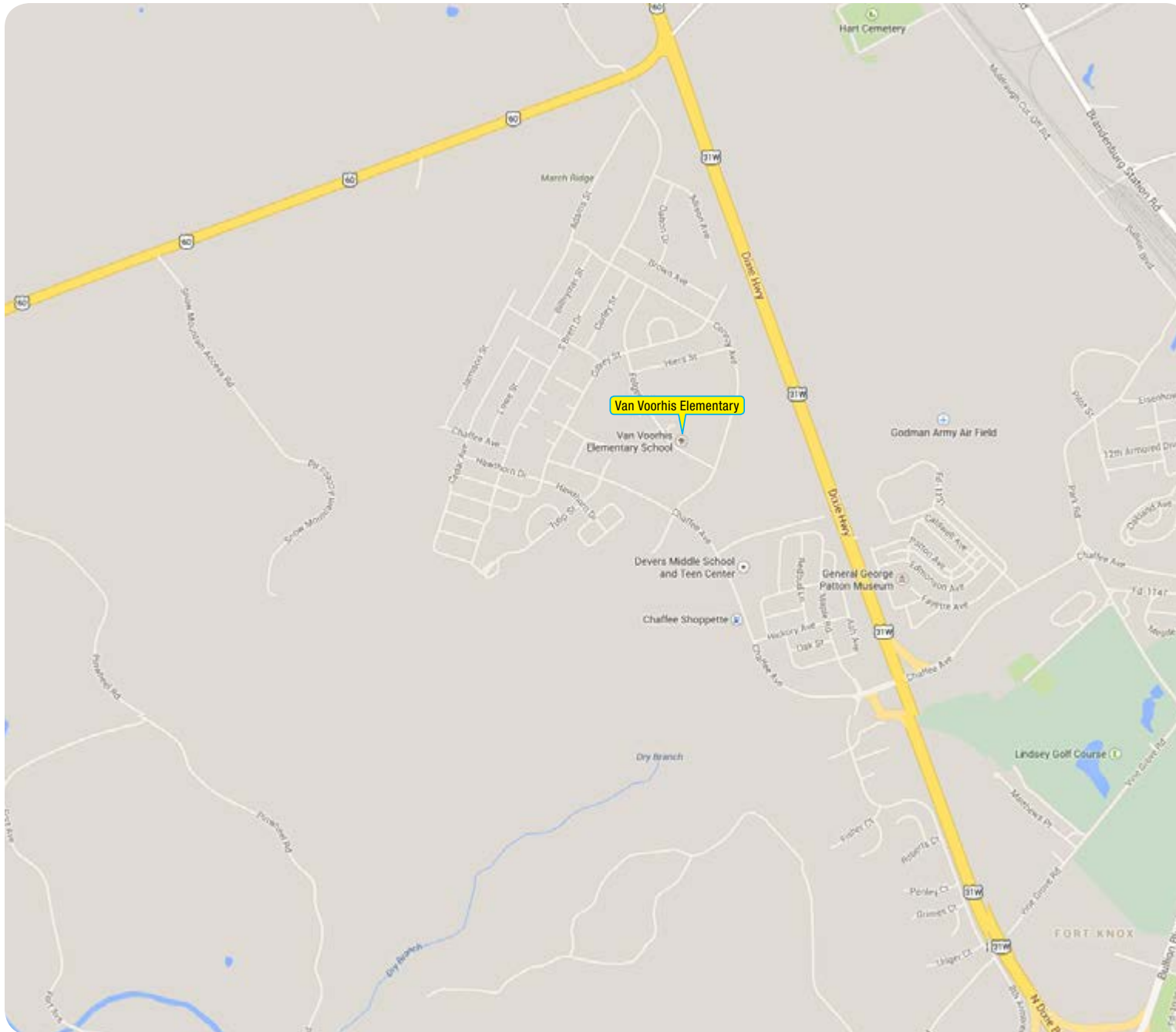

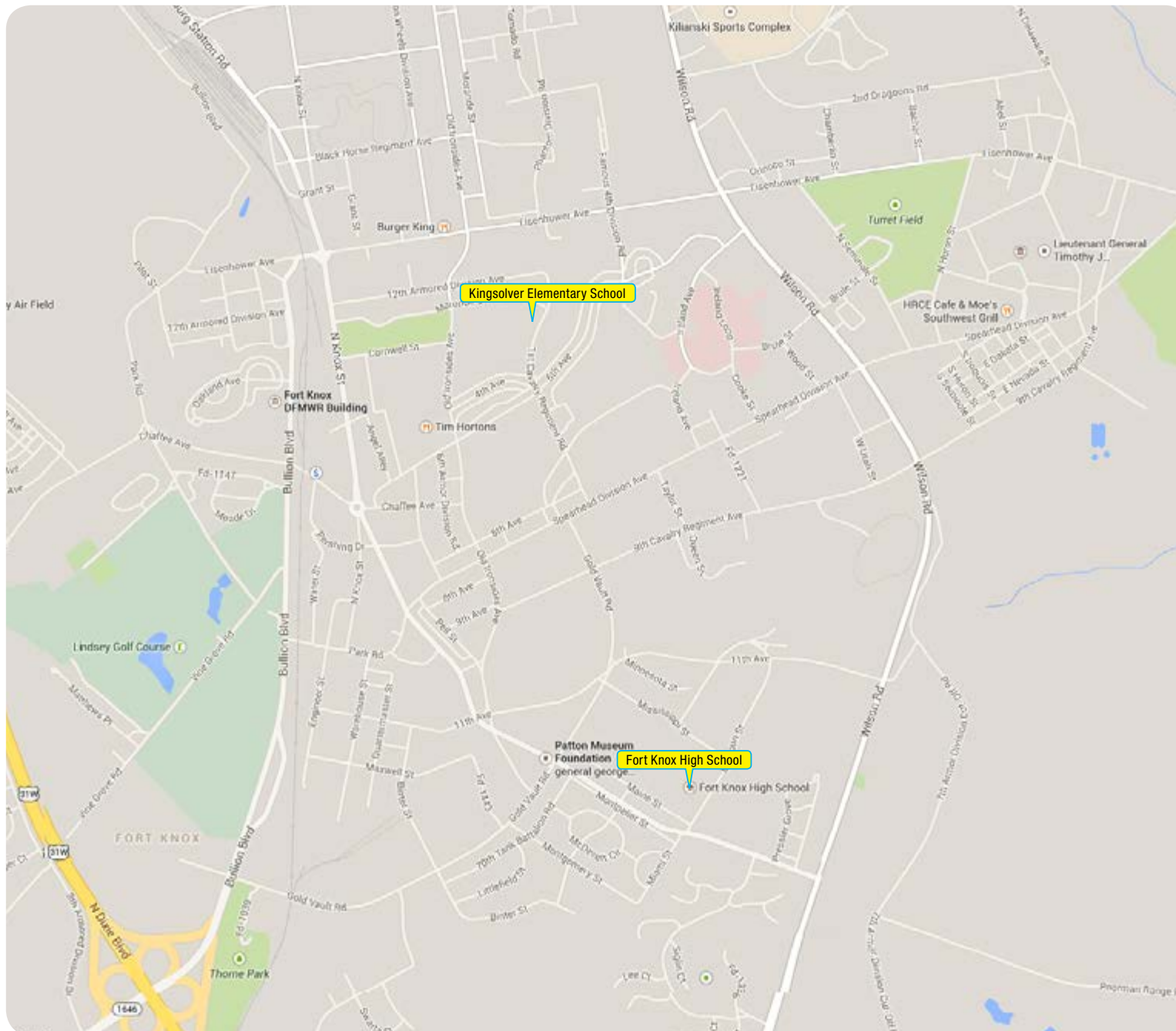
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# Map of Historic Community
