TRASH & RECYCLING SCHEDULE

Trash is collected on a weekly basis in each neighborhood via the schedule below. Please ensure trash bins are placed at the curb the evening prior to your collection date with the handle and tires facing the curb. Once the trash is collected, please return your trash container to its proper place on the same day as collection. During weeks with holiday closures, any changes to the trash collection will be provided to residents via email notices and posts on the Knox Hills Facebook page.

Knox Hills offers recycling drop-off bins in neighborhoods located in our three communities. The bins are for drop-off of the items listed below only. Bulk items and household trash are not permitted in the bins at any time.

THE BINS ARE LOCATED IN THE FOLLOWING AREAS:

Historic/Airfield Area

In the Godman Neighborhood off Walsh Street - parallel to Warhawk and Sumner

Oak Park Community

North Tulip which is the open road with no homes.

Dietz Community

In the gravel parking lot of the Dietz Community Center.



GREEN BINS


are for the following recyclables:

- #1 and #2 pre-rinsed plastics (the number type of plastics can be located in the middle of the recycle triangle on the item)
- White paper, newspaper, aluminum, and steel cans



BLUE BINS

are solely for **cardboard** that has been broken down prior to dropoff.







BULK TRASH

PROCEDURE FOR SCHEDULING YOUR BULK TRASH PICKUP

Knox Hills is proud to offer bulk trash pickup to our residents. Please familiarize yourself with the following information to schedule bulk item pickup:

- Bulk trash is limited to two items per scheduled pickup and must be scheduled through your community office by using the following information:
 - Dietz 502-799-6570 dietzteam@knoxhills.com
 - Oak Park 502-799-6580 oakparkteam@knoxhills.com
- Your community team will gather information from you regarding the items to be collected and confirm with you that they are acceptable for pickup. Your request will then be emailed to Republic Services for confirmation within 24 business hours of the initial request.
- Republic will confirm a collection date and your community team will share this
 information with you. Please note the collection of bulk pickup is scheduled only by
 Republic Services and collection typically occurs within one week of the request or
 otherwise communicated.
- If you have excessive bulk trash or do not wish to wait to schedule bulk trash for pickup, residents can utilize the Pearl Hollow Landfill located at 1620 Audubon Trace, Elizabethtown, KY 42701. A fee will be charged by the landfill for this service.

NOTE: Knowingly placing or throwing litter on any public or private property is a Class A misdemeanor.
