## RECYCLING MADE EASY

Island Palm Communities has an established curbside recycling programs to reduce recyclable waste going into the landfill. Each household should only use the recycling containers for recyclable items.

Also available to Island Palm Communities' residents is the bulk item pick-up option that will take larger materials that generally do not fit into the recycle bins and are not suitable for normal refuse disposal.

Plastic bottles (#1, #7, PET, HDPE)-emptied and rinsed-caps removed	Household furniture
Glass bottles (used for food & drink) emptied and rinsed - caps removed	Refrigerators (tightly secured with doors tied shut), freezers, air-conditioning units, and electronics.
Aluminum cans - emptied and rinsed	Large items such as toys, bikes, etc.
Aluminum containers - emptied and rinsed	Grills (NO propane tanks)
Bi-metal cans - emptied and rinsed	Mattresses
Office-type paper	Bed frames - disassembled
Telephone books	Work-out equipment - disassembled
Cardboard-corrugated-broken down flat	Playground equipment - disassembled
<b>NO*</b>	<b>NO**</b>
Newspapers - including glossy pages	Construction debris, rocks, dirt, bricks, CMU blocks, car parts, and hazardous chemicals
Cereal boxes, etc. (non-corrugated cardboard) / flat board - broken down flat	Hazardous chemicals
Magazines	Engines / large car parts
Plastic grocery bags	Car batteries / tires / used oil
Ceramics	Rocks, dirt, CMU blocks
Polystyrene foam (styrofoam)	Propane tanks
Shredded paper / confetti	Paint or paint cans
Clothing / shoes / toys	Aerosol cans
