Manuatory Fire Inspection ...

A mandatory fire code inspection will be coming up sometime in April. This inspection is done yearly by the city fire department for your protection.

Also, please remember, the state fire code strictly prohibits any flame type heating or cooking devices to be stored or used on upstairs balconies, inside breezeways or in your apt.

Warmer weather has brought out the bugs already. One of the most worrisome bugs is the Box Elder. This bug looks kind of like a lightening bug but has orange markings on



Lightning Safety Rules

Lightning is the #2 storm related killer. In Kentucky, more people are killed by lightning in an average year than by tornadoes. Although severe thunderstorm warnings are not issued for lightning you should move to shelter whenever thunder is heard, as lightning can strike 10-15 miles away from where rain is actually falling.

- If outside, go to a safe shelter immediately, such as inside a sturdy building. A hard top vehicle with the windows up can also offer fair protection from lightning.
- If you are on or near water, move to a safe shelter away from the water immediately!
- If you are in a wooded area seek shelter under a thick growth of relatively small trees if no indoor shelter is available. Taller trees attract lighting as lighting searches for the closest possible object.
- If you feel your hair standing on end, squat with your head between your knees, do NOT lie flat.
 - Avoid isolated trees or other tall objects, bodies of water, convertible cars, tractors and motorcycles.
- Avoid using the telephone (except for emergencies) or other electrical appliances.
- Avoid taking a bath or shower during a thunderstorm.



Tornado/Severe Thunderstorm Safety Rules

- If an underground shelter is not available, move to a small interior room or hallway on the lowest floor possible and get under a sturdy piece of furniture. Put as many walls as possible between you and the outdoors.
 - Stay away from windows.
 - Get out of automobiles.
- Do not try to outrun a tornado in your car: instead, leave it immediately for safe shelter. Do not seek shelter in an underpass.
 - If caught outside or in a vehicle, lie flat in a nearby ditch or depression and cover your head with your hands.
 - Be aware of flying debris. Flying debris from tornados and high winds cause most fatalities and injuries.

Hi-Point tenants should go to an interior closet or bathroom. If you live upstairs go to a downstairs neighbor's apartment if possible.
